### YEAR ROUND PROGRAMS

**Opportunity with your \$20 SC District Dues:**  
South Central District Meeting: A one day meeting held late October or early November. Registration for the District Meeting is \$15 per student. This fee includes lunch and covers the costs of the speakers. It is an awesome, one day, opportunity for students and advisors to network with students from other schools.

**Opportunities with your \$100 MASC Dues:**  
State Convention: Held in March at a host school, this is an excellent opportunity for students and advisors from all over the state to come together. There are usually over 600 students and 200 advisors that attend.

MASC Summer Leadership Workshop: This event is held annually in June at Williams Wood University in Fulton. Over 600 high school and middle schools students attend the week-long event. Goal setting, project planning, leadership styles, idea exchanges, and hands on community service are a few of the many benefits to this camp.

**Opportunities for Advisor Training:** Advisors Conference: Held in October at the Lake of the Ozarks. This conference will provide information on community service ideas, school spirit, fundraising, leadership training including Leadership Class. It is also a great place to network with other advisors from around the state.

### SERVICE OPPORTUNITIES

MASC is a state partner with Missouri Special Olympics. Many of our schools participate in the Polar Plunge, play on unified teams and/or help with SOMO events. MASC and SOMO have worked together for many years.
