MASC Distinguished Student Leaders is the newest program sponsored by the Missouri Association of Student Councils. It was created to motivate and challenge student leaders to extend their leadership skills and activities and to confer Missouri recognition upon those students who demonstrate superior student council leadership skills and knowledge based on MASC criteria and evaluation procedures.

To become a MASC Distinguished Student Leader, students must be members of their student councils in MASC member schools and graduating at the time they submit their applications. The standards for the Distinguished Student Leader program reflect the core purposes and mission of student councils. Additionally, the evaluation procedure has been designed so that the bulk of the process takes place at the school level with the results being forwarded to MASC for the final assessment. This facilitates a process that will help students become more proficient in self-assessment practices and better able to organize and build a record of evidence focused on their student council and related leadership activities.

The MASC Distinguished Student Leader designation will be bestowed upon any student that has shown evidence of being a knowledgeable and effective leader and has met the program criteria upon high school graduation. The following pages contain the eligibility standards and activities for students to become a MASC Distinguished Student Leader.

## MASC Distinguished Student Leader Application

### Eligibility

1. Students who apply to become MASC Distinguished Student Leaders must be in schools that have current MASC membership and current District membership at the time the applications are submitted to MASC for final evaluation.
2. Student must have participated at least two years in their high school student council.
3. Student must complete 20 hours of documented community service.
4. Student must have led one workshop/discussion group at district, state, national, MASC Summer Leadership workshops/conference. Proof of leading a workshop in your home student council or school district would qualify. (You must attach workshop handout).
5. Student must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 during their high school career.
6. Student must maintain an attendance rate of 95 percent.
7. Student must have no major disciplinary records or infractions as determined by your school district.
8. Student must have attended one of the following: District Convention, MASC State Convention, or MASC Winter Energizer.
9. Student must have attended the MASC Summer Leadership Workshop during grades 9-12.

### Regulations

1. Students must meet all criteria and submit a completed application and checklist to their student council advisor.
2. The application must be signed by the student applicant, school principal, and student council advisor.
3. **Submit only the requested forms indicated on the Check List.** No other items will be considered during the evaluation process. All submissions should be made on standard 8 ½ x 11" paper. Application materials must be bound by staple or secured in a report folder. Please do not use 3-ring binders or notebooks
4. Student Council Advisor must complete official MASC application form and submit to MASC Office by deadline to receive certificates for high school graduation ceremony.
5. ***Applications missing required information, signatures, or not in compliance with the regulations will not be evaluated by MASC.***

### MASC Distinguished Student Leader Application Procedures

1. Students demonstrate mastery of student council participation, leadership and collect evidence showing they meet the qualifications to become Missouri Distinguished Student Leaders.
2. The students prepare their applications and portfolios, and then meet with the principal and advisor to present their evidence of having completed the criteria.
3. If the principal and advisor find that the student has provided all necessary evidence of meeting the criteria, they will each confirm it with their signatures.
4. Following affirmation by the principal and advisor, the student council advisor should prepare all requested forms for shipment to MASC.
